### THIS WEEK FROM THE PRINCIPAL

**Traffic** – Thank you to all the parents who drive your children to school for the improvement in safe traffic behaviour out the front of the school. The drop off and pickup area is flowing well, and the parking restrictions are being observed. Shortly we will be installing new banners to remind drivers of time limits, because as the weather gets colder and wetter, people tend to try and get their cars as close to the front gate as possible. The reduced speed limit and 'speed bumps' have had a positive effect and have also reduced the number of vehicles using School Road as a 'short cut' between Anglesea Rd and the Great Ocean Road. Also, please encourage your kids to only use the supervised crossing, as it is really difficult for drivers to see small children who run across the road or dart out between cars.

Attitudes to School Survey – Over the coming weeks students in Grades Four, Five and Six will participate in the annual student survey. This gives your children the opportunity to express their views on a variety of topics including their learning environment, safety, engagement and connection to school, perspectives on bullying and student voice and agency. All responses are anonymous, and students are encouraged to be open and honest in the way they respond to the questions. Once we get the results, we will share them with our school community and the data helps inform our staff as to how we can improve the learning experience for your children.

School Council – At our last meeting we spent a considerable amount of time discussing the way forward with the proposed new playground that will in part be funded from fundraising events such as the Mayfair. Although we are only in the initial phase of planning, the intention is to repurpose the existing equipment at the front of the school and add it to the play area in the southwestern part of the campus. This will then make space for an entirely new playground at the front with a range of diverse equipment, a rubber base for safety and easier ongoing maintenance, as well as softer colour tones to blend in with the front of the school. As the installation of play equipment is an expensive exercise, the School Council has agreed to access some money from the school's official bank account to supplement the money that has been accumulated through fundraising.

**Lost property** – Moving into winter we tend to have more and more items of clothing turn up in our 'lost property.' Please label all your children's clothing and ask them to check that they have their hoody/jacket/jumper with them before they leave school.

**Prep Incursion** – Today our prep students all enjoyed an interesting incursion from 'Coastal Nectar.' It was a fantastic learning opportunity for our young students to learn about bees and their importance to humans in the global food supply chain. Bees not only provide us with delicious honey but also play a crucial role in food production and the broader environment. As such, we need to protect their habitat and promote their pollination of crops. *Bee fact: There are over 20000 species of bees that exist globally and over 2000 native bee species are in Australia!* 

Enjoy the weekend and we hope everyone is coping with the sudden drop in temperature!
